The scholarship program was organized for the purpose of promoting the higher education or technical education by granting scholarships for continuing educational opportunities to eligible participants.

The 2022-23 CEF scholarship application form can be picked up at the counseling office at Coweta High School. Please refer to the official rules on the application form for details. The amount of each scholarship will be determined by available funding.

Applications will be due to the counseling office at Coweta High School by **April 24th**. Scholarship recipients will be notified by mail or phone in late spring. Thank you for your continued support of the Coweta Educational Foundation.

Official Rules

This grant of \$1,000 will be made to a student to defray the cost of tuition, books, or room and board at an accredited institution of higher learning or technical school approved by the CEF. Disbursement of the money will be made upon the presentation of the winners' college/university or technical school invoice as proof of full time enrollment. The scholarship money will be awarded directly to the college/university or technical school. Applicants must be a graduating senior of Coweta Public Schools. The student must have financial need and maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher. **In order to be eligible for a scholarship, applicants must complete the application form in its entirety and return to CEF by the entry postmark deadline, April 24th.** Applicants will be evaluated on a comparative basis at the sole discretion of the committee. Decisions will be final. Recipients will be notified by mail or phone. No transfer of scholarship is permitted. Application material and decisions of the committee will be confidential. Acceptance of scholarship constitutes permission to use recipients name and/or likeness for purpose of promotion.
